Funding Application Guidelines

The trust deed provides for the capital /and or income to be applied for such charitable purposes in New Zealand as the trustee in its absolute discretion shall think fit.

For 2017, the focus will be for the benefit of the following sectors:

- Art/Culture/heritage;
- Emergency/disaster relief;
- Religious activities;

Period and Processing of Funding

- Applications to be considered as a recipient for funding are assessed annually. The next granting cycle will be from **8th June 2017 to 26th June 2017**.
- The amount to be distributed this year is approximately **\$110,000**.
- All applications must be completed via the attached online application form.
- The length of the assessment process is dependent on the volume of applications and all applicants are notified of the decision. During the assessment period, trustees may request further clarification from the applicant regarding their application.

Regrettably, due to the number of applications we receive, we are unable to provide detailed feedback on unsuccessful applications. Please note the decision of the Trustees is final and not subject to any appeals process.
